


## Create a Twitter Account

Go to [www.twitter.com](http://www.twitter.com)




The screenshot shows the Twitter sign-up page with the following fields and a button:

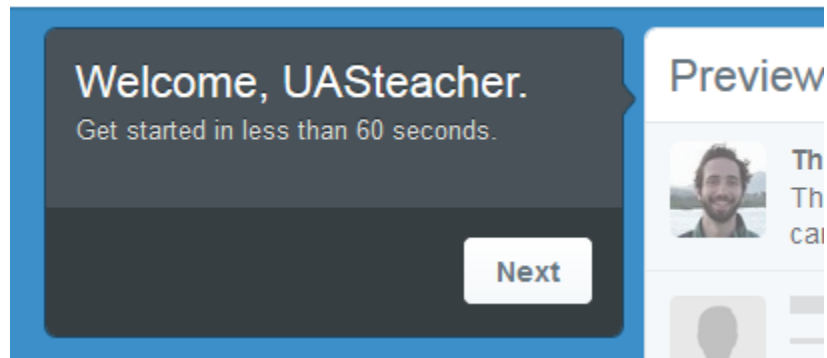

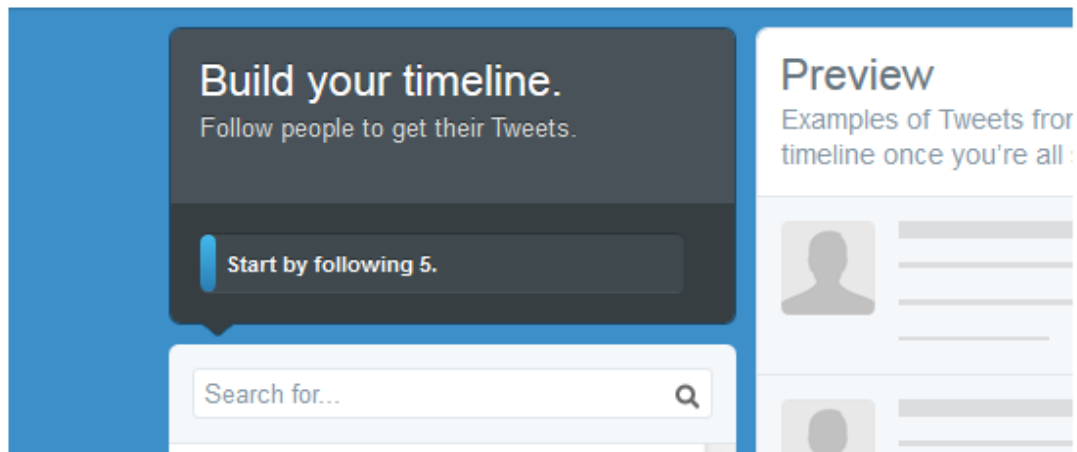
Confirm your information and choose a username - this will be public - it will be your "handle" for people to refer to you in tweets

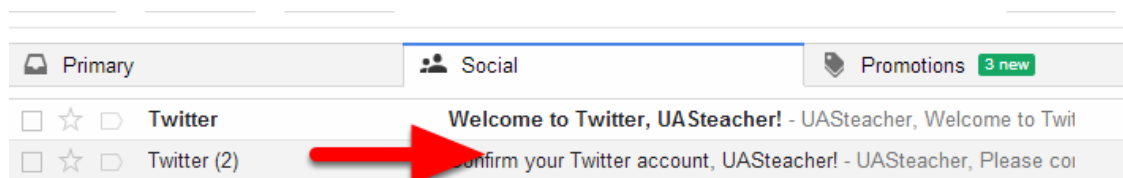
Click the big Next button

## Skip the next part



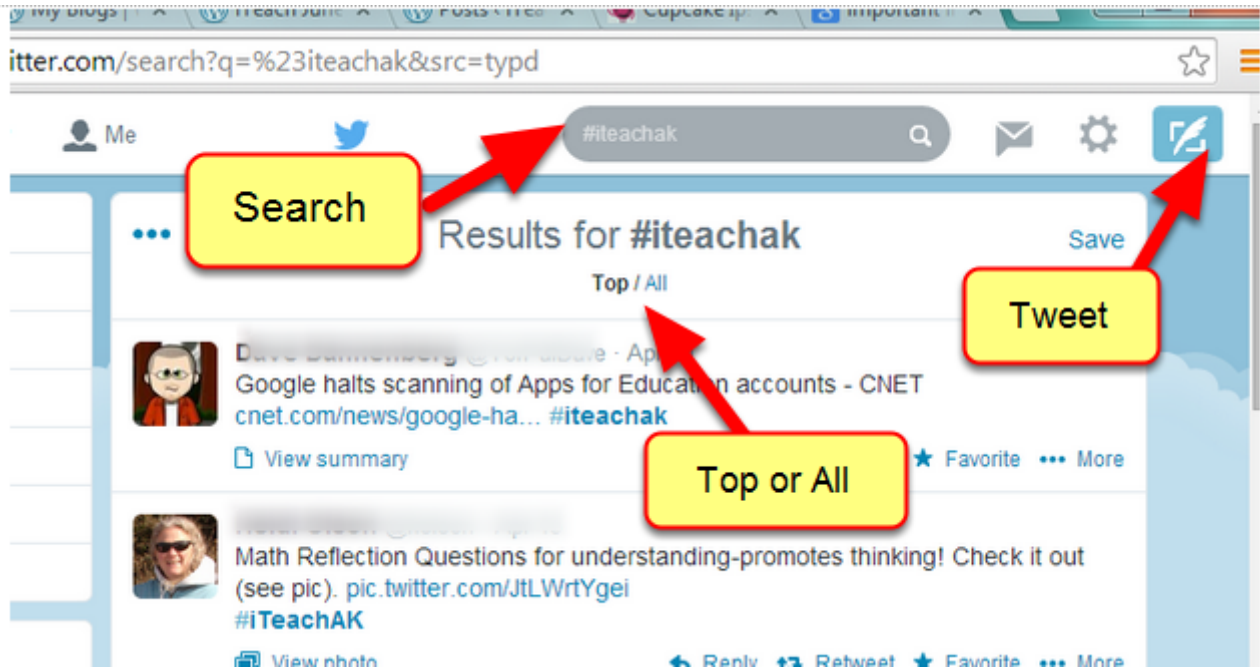
You don't have to "Build Your Timeline" now - there is not obvious exit, just type [www.twitter.com](http://www.twitter.com) in the address bar to get out of here.

## Confirm your email



Go to your email and confirm your account. Note - if you use gmail online then it may be sorted into "Social"

## Search for #iteachak



Once you've confirmed your account go back to [www.twitter.com](http://www.twitter.com) and sign in.

- Search for #iteachak - that's the hashtag we'll be using to post comments and share links and resources. The same hashtag is used by iTeach participants from other UA campuses
- Notice that you can look at Top or All posts - Top will probably show the most frequent tweeters.
- Click the blue quill pen/paper icon to send a "tweet". Type the hashtag "#iteachak" anywhere in your post to include it in this on-going conversation.
